Difficult species:

Difficult 1: **Very poor accommodation**

Harwood Spurfowl, Yellow-throated Serin, Salvadori's seedeater. Bale Mountain national park.

Difficult 2: **Fitness and hiking**

Yellow-fronted Parrot, Ruspoli's Turaco, Abyssinian Longclaw, Abyssinian Woodpecker, Bale mountain Parissoma.

Difficult 3: **Behaviour and habitat**

Ankober Serin, Abyssinian Ground Thrush, White-winged dove, Juba Weaver, Liben Lark, Yellow Fronted Parrot, Abyssinian Woodpecker are difficult to see.

Difficult 4: **Distance:**

Pale Rock finch, **Djibouti border** for Larks, Buntings, Nightjars and Wheatears. **Western Ethiopia** and **Northern Ethiopia** are difficult to cover over a period of three weeks.

Difficult 5: **Safety**

Somali border for Larks, Starlings and White-winged dove.
